

Some people can't stand the way we look.

Out of 100 characteristics we may use to judge gender, for example, how a person looks, acts, speaks, etc., the trans person often has less than 50% -- making the other uneasy because the trans person's "human likeness" is off – a psychological phenomenon known as the "Uncanny Valley."





### Gender Identity is a matter of brain neuroanatomy.

Trans People Really Are Born that Way.

[W]hen individuals of Sex A—despite having the chromosomes, gonads and sex hormones of that sex—insist that they're really Sex B, the gender affected parts of the brain typically more closely resemble [in MRI's, etc.] what's usually seen with Sex B...

The issue isn't that sometimes people believe they are of a different gender than they actually are. *Remarkably, instead, it's that sometimes people are born with bodies whose gender is different from what they actually are.*

The breakdown of the trans person's social structures, the loss of money, family, friends and social status and the hostility of the outside world to the trans person may lead to **Gender Dysphoria ("GD")**. Basically, GD is a "catch-all" diagnosis ideally used to guide medical and therapeutic procedures to aid the person.

The critical element of gender dysphoria is the presence of clinically significant distress [caused by destruction of social structures, loss of income, reaction of the world, etc.] associated with being trans.

- Trans people are diagnosed as suffering from GD when they have "clinically significant distress" associated with being trans.
- GD is a disability in that it substantially impairs one or more major life activities, including, but not limited to, neurological, brain, social, and occupational functions.
